





EFLM CARDIAC MARKER AWARD for remarkable scientific work in the field of cardiovascular diseases **sponsored by Hytest**

EFLM is very pleased of the collaboration with Hytest for this Award through which we intend to achieve wider recognition of the importance of high-quality research in the field of cardiac markers among laboratory professionals in Europe.



EFLM is pleased to announce the "EFLM Cardiac Marker Award for remarkable scientific work in the field of cardiovascular diseases - sponsored by Hytest". The Award is given to the best published paper, as judged by an independent panel of experts, which demonstrates a remarkable scientific work in the field of cardiovascular diseases. The Award, consisting of a certificate and a sum of 5,000 Euro, will be presented to the winner at the 26th IFCC-EFLM EuroMedLab Congress in Brussels (18-22 May 2025). The Award will be presented to the first author, who is responsible for division of the award among his/her co-authors.

Applications must be submitted by the first author of the paper and must be accompanied by:

- Reprint of the publication or (in case of publications in press), a manuscript copy and a copy of the journal Editor's letter indicating the final acceptance for publication;
- A short bio sketch of the submitting author;
- Document proving the membership to an EFLM Full Member National Society/Association;
- Copy of the ID proving the age of the applicant;
- Statement signed by all authors of the publication consenting to submission of the paper for the Award and to the conditions of entry.

Entry Criteria

- the submitting author must be a young scientist less than 40 years of age as of 1st January 2025, First Author of the paper and from a National Society/Association Full Member of EFLM. The applicant is limited to one submission only;
- entries must be published studies
 demonstrating remarkable scientific work in the field of cardiac marker measurements and risk assessments of cardiovascular
 diseases. Only original research articles are eligible. Reviews, opinion papers, or papers out of the scope of the Award will not be accepted for evaluation;
- entries must have been published or accepted for publication between 1 January 2024 – 19 January 2025 and must be published in English in a peer-reviewed medical, scientific or health economics journal;
 - studies all authors of the publication have to agree work in on the submission of the paper for the ements Award and to the conditions of entry;
 - the applicant must not have applied or be nominated for any other on-going EFLM or IFCC Awards and neither must result as the winner of those Awards in the same year when the award is presented.
